



THE INTEGRAL ART: CURRENT FRONTIERS AND POSSIBLE FUTURES

In little more than a decade, “integral” has matured from a mere idea to a major movement. What is the current state of the integral art—its present applications and cutting edges? And what is its future potential—what novel extensions and applications can we glimpse or only guess at? What traps await us, and what forms will our individual and collective integral shadows take? And how can we best avoid these traps, embody the integral vision, and help to resolve the enormous challenges that confront our troubled world. This presentation will explore these questions both conceptually and experientially.

Roger Walsh MD, Ph.D. is a professor of psychiatry, philosophy and anthropology, as well as adjunct professor of religious studies at the University of California at Irvine. His research and writings have received over two dozen national and international awards and honors while his teaching has received one national and six university awards. His publications include *The World of Shamanism*, *Paths Beyond Ego*, and *Essential Spirituality: The Seven Essential Practices*.

RESEARCH DEVELOPMENT: FROM LOEVINGER’S CONVENTIONAL TO CURRENT POSTCONVENTIONAL EGO DEVELOPMENT THEORY, AND FUTURE SCHOLARSHIP CHALLENGES.

I will start with a tribute to the late Jane Loevinger, who was at the forefront of psychological science at the time of her seminal contributions. Next I will suggest that ego development theory itself moved from a conventional to a postconventional paradigm. To support novice researchers, differences in attitude towards knowledge and style in science writing will be made explicit. I will also cover some new findings about the later stages and their stage-specific shadows. Finally I will conclude with challenges of future scholarship at the high-end of ego development theory especially differentiating high state stage and structure stage development.

Susanne Cook-Greuter, Ed.D. is internationally known as the leading expert in mature ego development and self-actualization. She does ongoing research and development on the Sentence Completion Test. Susanne leads trainings in the Leadership Development Framework and introductions and certification training for SCT-scorers. She collaborates with other consultants in bringing a developmental perspective into corporations and executive teams.



Integral Field Courses


Beginning in 2007 JFK University's Integral Studies Department began offering *Integral Field Courses*. The field courses orient around a central thread of how Integral Theory can be brought to bear on complex, global issues today. These 10-day courses offer students of Integral Theory an opportunity to engage in practical application of the model in the field, through partnership with integrally-informed organizations in other countries. In particular, courses explore how the leaders within these organizations use folk Integral methods (i.e., informal and intuitive uses of 1st-, 2nd-, and 3rd-person practices), as well as those who are applying Integral Theory more fully in their programming.

The first course went to El Salvador in Fall 2007. The next course will go Peru in Spring 2009. In the following years we are planning on offering courses in Ethiopia, Nigeria and South Africa. We are in the process of developing courses to occur domestically in the United States as well. These field courses are available to graduate students and also to working professionals as a continuing education opportunity. 


